## Instrumental Band Program – Introduction

Dear Parents,

Today your child attended a Band Demonstration Concert at school showcasing the various brass, woodwind and percussion instruments available for students to learn in 2012. If you would like more information on the school band program please return the *Expression of Interest* below within **5 DAYS** to your school office.

If we receive your *Expression of Interest* **within 5 days**, a time will be arranged for your child to meet with the Band Director to try out the instruments available to learn. At this time, an *Enrolment Pack* will be sent home with your child containing detailed information about TSA's School Band Program. There will also be a summary of your child's instrument 'test run' with any recommendations regarding instrument choice and suitability.

Below is an outline of *how* our Band Program works and *what* the costs are to you. Additional detailed information will be sent home in your *Enrolment Pack*.

### ***HOW our Band Program works:***

A professional musician/teacher conducts a weekly **band rehearsal** (large ensemble) for 30-45 minutes usually before school, **PLUS** teaches students on the same day in 30-minute **group lessons** (approx 5 per group). Group lessons are timetabled during school time in conjunction with the principal & class teachers. Home practice is also essential.

### ***WHAT the costs are to you:***

- **Tuition fees** (includes weekly 30 minute group lesson **and** weekly band rehearsal) – \$140 per term (students who elect to receive external, private tuition can enroll in the large rehearsal only known as *band only* – \$70 per term)
- **An Instrument** can be **purchased** (expect to pay at least \$600 for a decent quality new wind or brass instrument, slightly less second hand), **hired** (TSA runs a **rent-to-buy** scheme starting at \$43 per month) or occasionally **borrowed** from family, friends, school or community bands.
- **Other costs** include a tutor book – \$14.95, optional music stand – \$20, plus occasional accessories such as reeds (\$2-3), plastic sleeve folders, band music. Some schools also charge a \$10 resource levy.
